

Application for The Masters Degree
Applied Cognition and Neuroscience
Scholarship Award

The Applied Cognition and Neuroscience Program is pleased to announce the availability of a limited number of \$1,000 *Applied Cognition and Neuroscience Scholarship Awards*. These highly competitive awards are awarded based upon a criteria of academic excellence. The scholarship amount is \$1000. Moreover, students currently classified as out-of-state and who receive a \$1,000 scholarship in the fall 2010 semester are eligible for in-state tuition rates during the fall 2010, spring 2011, and summer 2011 semesters.

Application Deadline: *May 1, 2010*

Award Start Date: Fall Semester of the Year Application is Submitted

Eligibility. You are eligible for the ACN Scholarship Award if:

- You have been accepted into the ACN Program
- Your first semester of classes occurs in the Fall, Spring, or Summer of the Award Start Date Year (e.g., Fall 2010, Spring 2010, Summer 2010)
- You will be a full-time ACN masters student (i.e., taking 9 credit hours per semester)

Criteria for the Award. Evidence of academic excellence which includes factors such as: grade point average at previous universities, GRE scores, statement of purpose, letters of reference, prior research work, and prior course work.

How to apply for the Award. No application is necessary but the Statement of Purpose included in your admissions application must include the following items:

- Explicit statement of your interest in receiving the ACN Scholarship Award
- Explicit statement of your Specialization Area
- Explicit statement of how your undergraduate work has prepared you for pursuing the ACN Masters Degree in your specialization area of interest.
- Explicit statement of your post-graduate and long-term career objectives.
- Explicit statement that you intend to pursue the ACN degree as a full-time student.

Contact Information. In order to qualify for the ACN Scholarship Award, you must make sure that you meet the eligibility requirements of the Award before the May 1 deadline. In order to ensure that eligibility requirements have been met, students are encouraged to contact Melanie (mkd081000@utdallas.edu) *before April 1* of the Award Start Date Year.
